According to the new BC Societies Act (effective Nov. 28, 2016), and as per bylaw 7.2 "Qualifications of Directors":

A member **may not** be nominated, elected, or appointed to serve as a Director if they:

- (a) Are less than 18 years old.
- (b) Found by any court, in Canada or elsewhere, to be incapable of managing their own affairs.
- (c) Has an undischarged bankruptcy.
- (d) Has been convicted of a prescribed offence in accordance with the BC Societies Act.
- (e) Are not a member in good standing.
- (f) Has been an employee of the Association within the last 12 months.
- (g) Been a contractor for services to the Association within the last 12 months.

Further to this, per bylaw 8.6 "Nomination and Election Policies", in order to maintain the Association's philosophy of board continuity and successorship, a Member seeking nomination must be a continuing employee or have a temporary contract that expires after the end of term they are nominated for.
