  - (i) the court orders otherwise,
  - (ii) 5 years have elapsed since the last to occur of
    - (a) the expiration of the period set for suspension of the passing of sentence without a sentence having been passed,
    - (b) the imposition of a fine,
    - (c) the conclusion of the term of any imprisonment, and
    - (d) the conclusion of the term of any probation imposed, or
  - (iii) a pardon was granted or issued, or a record suspension was ordered, under the *Criminal Records Act* (Canada) and the pardon or record suspension, as the case may be, has not been revoked or ceased to have effect.
